This revision is filed against the impugned order dated 25.01.2023 whereby, the Learned 1st Additional Sessions Judge, Raipur in an appeal, considering the application under Section 391 of Cr.P.C. has dismissed the application of the applicant. During the course of arguments, Counsel for the applicant submits that the order is of interim nature. This revision is filed under the provisions of Section 397 and 401 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973. Considering the nature of order which is found to be interim in nature, learned counsel for the applicant submits that he may be permitted to convert this revision in a petition under Section 482 of Cr.P.C.. Counsel for the applicant submits that he may be granted a week's time to convert the nomenclature of the proceedings filed within the said period and he will also file the amended petition. In view of the submissions made, 10 days time is granted to counsel for the applicant to take necessary steps to convert this criminal revision into a proceeding/petition under Section 482 of Cr.P.C.
