07.04.2025	Mr. Sudhir Agrawal, counsel for the appellant. Heard on I.A. No. 01/2025, an application for grant of stay. Learned counsel for the appellant would submit that the appellant/Insurance company has challenge the quantum of compensation as the learned tribunal wrongly deducted 1/3 from income of the deceased, whereas, the tribunal ought to have deducted 1/2. He would further submit that an issue of contributory negligence was wrongly decided against the Insurance company. He would pray for grant of stay. Taking into consideration the submission made by Mr. Agrawal, I.A. No. 01/2025 is hereby allowed. If the appellant/ Insurance company deposit 75% of the award amount before the Claims tribunal within a period of 60 days from today, payment of remaining award amount shall

remain stayed till further orders.

The claimants/respondents No. 1 to 3 shall be entitled to withdraw the award amount, as per the terms and conditions mentioned in the award.

Issue a fresh notice to respondents No. 1 to 5 on payment of P.F. by ordinary as well as registered mode.

Call this matter thereafter.
