State/respondent No.1 and perused the impugned F.I.R.

It has been submitted by the learned counsel for the petitioners that respondent No. 02 herein is the divorced wife of petitioner No. 01, former daughter-in-law of petitioner Nos. 02 & 03, and former sister-in-law of petitioner No. 04. She has lodged a false FIR against all the petitioners herein alleging that petitioners have subjected her to cruelty. The FIR lodged by the respondent No. 02 is false, frivolous, based on concocted cooked-up stories and it lacks substance & merit.

Considering the fact that the dispute arrived at between the parties is matrimonial in nature, we deem it appropriate to make an effort to get the said dispute settled by way of mediation.

In view of the above, petitioner No.1 shall deposit a sum of Rs.50,000/- with the Mediation Centre of this Court within a period of one week from today and the same shall be paid to respondent No.2/ complainant on

her appearance before the Mediation Centre.

Parties are directed to appear before the Mediation Centre of this Court on **09.03.2026**.

Learned State counsel is directed to inform the private respondent *i.e.* respondent No. 2 about passing of this order, so that she may appear before the Mediation Centre on the aforesaid date.

List this matter along with report of Mediation Centre before this Court on **17.03.2026**.

It is also made clear that if any final settlement is arrived at between the parties, the aforesaid amount so deposited, shall be adjusted.
