10/08/2023	Shri Tarun Dansena, Advocate appears on behalf of Shri Manish Upadhyay, counsel for the Appellant. The appellant is in person before this Court as also the respondent. The decree was passed for payment of <i>Stridhan</i> and during the course of hearing of the appeal, the appellant stated that pursuant to the interim order passed on 01.09.2022, which comes to 50% of the decretal sum i.e. Rs.5,00,000/- would be paid by him. Few dates passed by and in certain intermediate period certain amounts were paid and order sheet of 02.03.2023 would show that he admits that Rs.2,50,000/- was remains to be paid and subsequently, on 19.4.2023, an amount of Rs.30,000/- was paid. Today, the appellant who appears in person, again gave an undertaking to the Court that he may be given 15 days' time to pay the amount. The conduct of the appellant appears to be that on a promise being made to the Court, the dates were adjourned, but eventually that undertaking is not fulfilled. Primarily, it sounds in contempt and making a false averment before the Court. The respondent, who is in person would submit that the appellant is still in hold of the entire <i>Stridhan</i>. Without going into that and since on the earlier occasion, the

undertaking was extended and the appellant again prays for some time to pay the amount and makes a submission that in case, the amount is not arranged, he will sell certain property to make the payment.

Considering such submission made, we grant another 15 days time to the appellant to make good the payment.

List the matter on 24th August, 2023. On that day, both the parties shall remain present before this Court.
