Shri Kishore Bhaduri, Senior Advocate with Shri Ravindra Agrawal, Advocate for respondent Nos.1 & 2. Shri Sameer Oraon, GA for respondent No.3/State. Heard. Issue notice to the respondents. Learned counsel for the respective respondents accept notice on behalf of the respondents. Hence, process fee is not required to be paid. Learned counsel for respondents submits that they may be granted two weeks' time to file reply to the appeal as well as IA No.1, application for grant of interim relief/stay. Learned Senior Counsel for respondents No.1 & 2 submits that respondent Nos.1 & 2 have also preferred an appeal challenging the impugned order, which is yet to be listed before this Court. Learned Senior Counsel for appellants submits that as appellants apprehend alienation of the suit property by respondent Nos.1 and 2, hence, application for grant of interim relief/stay of restraining respondent No.1 & 2 from alienating the property in dispute be considered today.

Learned counsel for respondent Nos.1 and 2 submits that he is having no objection as of now for considering the prayer as made by counsel for appellants.

In view of above submissions made by counsel for the parties, it is directed that parties to this appeal shall maintain 'Status Quo', as it exists today, with respect to the property in dispute till the next date of hearing.

At this stage, learned Senior Counsel for appellants submits this case may be fixed for hearing at the earliest.

As prayed, list the matter on **25.03.2022** for further hearing.
