Learned counsel for the appellant submits that though on the last date of hearing, the matter was adjourned on submission made by learned counsel for the appellant that there is possibility of amicable settlement between the parties as the appeal is

arising out of family dispute but today she prays that the appeal be sent for mediation Centre.

In view of the above, the matter is referred to the Mediation Centre and both the parties are directed to appear before the Mediation Centre of this Court on **23.03.2026** for exploring the possibility of amicable settlement.

The appellants are directed to communicate this order to the respondents forthwith. It is also clarified that the Mediation Centre shall issue notice to all respondents to ensure that they have an opportunity to participate in the mediation process. The Mediation Centre shall proceed only after satisfying itself that proper notice has been served upon all parties in accordance with law.

Registry is directed to communicate a copy of this order to the Mediation Centre for compliance.
