Also heard Mr. Malay Jain and Ms. Saumya Sharma, learned Panel Lawyers appearing for the respondents/ State as well as Ms. Anamika Jain, learned counsel for respondent No.2. Learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that in the present bunch of cases, the petitioner has been falsely implicated and has been roped in the multiple FIRs solely on the basis of being a star campaigner of Anmol India Company, despite no specific allegations. Multiple FIRs based on identical facts have been registered against the petitioner at different police stations, which is

not sustainable in the eyes of Law.

In view of the above, the Director General of Police, Chhattisgarh is directed to file his personal affidavit in all the present cases informing this Court whether the investigation concerning the petitioner has been concluded and whether the final report with respect to the FIRs registered against the petitioner has been submitted or not.

List these cases in the next week.
