Section 7 of the Family Court Act, presently pending before the learned 3<sup>rd</sup> Additional Principal Judge, Family Court, Durg, to the Family Court Bemetara, District Bemetara (C.G.).

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the marriage between the petitioner and the respondent was solemnized on 27.09.2024 in accordance with Muslim customs and rites. It is further submitted that the petitioner is presently residing at her parental home in District Bemetara (C.G.) along with her minor child aged about four months. Owing to her present circumstances and responsibility of taking care of the infant child, she is facing considerable hardship and inconvenience in attending the court proceedings at Durg.

In view of the above, issue notice to the respondent, by ordinary as well as registered post.



Process fee be paid within 10 days.

Considering the entire facts and circumstances of the case, further proceedings with respect to the Civil Suit No. A/1085/2025, pending before the Family Court, Durg shall remain stayed, till the next date of hearing.

Accordingly, I.A. No.1 is hereby disposed of.
