Heard on I.A. No.04/2025, application filed by Gajendra Kumar for permission to intervene in the instant petition. Learned counsel for the State-respondents raised strong objection on the ground that, the instant petition was filed by petitioners on 16.08.2019, but instant application for intervention has been filed on 18.03.2025 i.e. after delay of

On due consideration, having considered the delay and latches in filing intervention application, after lapse of more than five years, I do not feel inclined to allow aforesaid application, hence, the same is rejected.
