WPS No. 1638 of 2019Devendra Kumar Sen **Versus** State Of Chhattisgarh

08.03.2019	Ms. Rashul Bhawnani, counsel for the petitioner. Mr. Anshuman Shrivastava, PL for the State. Petition is admitted for hearing. Since all the respondents are represented though the State counsel, issuance of notice stands dispensed with. Heard on I. A. No. 1, which is an application for grant of interim relief. Issue notice on I.A. No. 1 also. The contention of the petitioner is that the petitioner is presently discharging duties of Guest Lecturer (Welder) in Mechanical Diesel Wing for quite sometime and that there is no order of any unsatisfactory performance of the petitioner, yet the respondents have now issued a fresh advertisement dated 21/02/2019 again advertising the post of Guest Lecturer for Welder that is the post on which the petitioner is discharging his duties. Given the fact that the petitioner is working as Guest Lecturer presently, this Court does not find any good reason why the services of the petitioner should be replaced by another Guest Lecturer particularly for the reason that the appointment made to the petitioner itself was



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that till a regular or contractual appointment as per rules, is not made or the services of the petitioner being discontinued on the ground of unsatisfactory work.

In the absence of either of the two, the petitioner, prima facie, could not be replaced by another set of Guest Lecturer. Accordingly, it is ordered that the advertisement dated 21/02/2019, so far as filling up of the post of Guest Lecturer(Welder) is concerned shall remain stayed till the next date of hearing.

Let reply be filed within a period of eight weeks and matter be listed thereafter.
