

**HIGH COURT OF CHHATTISGARH AT BILASPUR****MCRC No. 2013 of 2026**Vijay Verma **Versus** State of Chhattisgarh**Order Sheet**

27/02/2026	Heard Mr. Sudhanshu Kumar Singh and Mr. Harshvardhan Singh Thakur, appearing for the applicants. Also heard Ms. Nupur Trivedi, learned Panel Lawer, appearing for the non-applicant/State. Learned counsel appearing for the applicant submits that the applicant has been falsely implicated in the present case. It is submitted that nothing has been seized from the applicant and that the alleged stolen motorcycle was recovered from the co-accused, namely, Monesh Sahu @ Sahu. On the other hand, learned State Counsel submits that three motorcycles were recovered, out of which two were stolen and one was used in the commission of theft. She further submits that, in the present case, the



motorcycle bearing registration No. CG08-NB/0842, which is alleged to be stolen, was recovered from the possession of the present applicant.

In view of the above, learned counsel for the applicant is directed to explain, by way of an affidavit, whether the motorcycle recovered from the applicant was a stolen vehicle or not, and to clarify the circumstances of its recovery.

Let the matter be listed again after two weeks.
