The parties were directed to appear in person before this Court to explore the possibility of any settlement. A casual statement has been made by the learned counsel for the respondent that the respondent is not well, therefore he could not come. Neither any application have been filed nor any supportive document have been filed in respect of the ailment. The appellant is present alongwith her Advocate before this Court. The appellant would submit that they have come from Manendragarh - Chirmiri. It appears that the non-appearance is not bonafide. Even otherwise the appellant who has filed this appeal would submit that she has a very limited source of income, she runs a small saleable items. Considering the fact that no prior intimation was also given, we deem it proper to impose a cost of Rs.3000/- to be paid to the appellant by the respondent. It is further stated on behalf of the appellant that the non-appearance has been made with a design to further perform a second marriage. We see
