05/03/2025	Mr. Karundendra Narayan Singh, Advocate appearing on behalf of Mr. B. P. Sharma, Advocate for the petitioner. Mr. Manish Upadhyay, Advocate for the respondent. Heard on I.A. No. 01, application for grant of ad-interim relief. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that vide order dated 10.01.2025, the services of the petitioner has been terminated. Thereafter, the petitioner has filed a writ

petition in which he was directed to make a representation regarding his grievance and during the pendency of the his representation, a recovery notice dated 03.02.2025 has been issued against the petitioner. He submits that both the impugned orders are illegal, bad in law and deserve to be quashed/set-aside.

Considering the submissions advanced by counsel for the petitioner, purely as an interim measure, it is directed that the effect and operation of the impugned orders dated 10.01.2025 and the recovery order dated 03.02.2025 with respect to the petitioner shall remain stayed till the next date of hearing.

Learned State counsel is directed to file reply in the matter within four weeks.
