By way of above application, petitioner wants to add <u>Godawari Power & Ispat Ltd, Through the Director, office located at Plot No. 482/2, Phase I, Industrial Area, Siltara, Raipur - 493111, Chhattisgarh</u>, as respondent No.4 in the cause title of this petition, however, it has been stated by learned Senior Counsel appearing for the respondent/CMDC that said person/Firm has already completed the work which has been allotted to them, therefore, there is no need for align the said person. On due consideration of the facts and above submission, IA



	No.3/2025 is liable to be and is hereby rejected. Mr. Abhishek Sinha, learned Senior Counsel appearing for the respondent/Chhattisgarh Mineral Development Corporation (CMDC) has pointed out that respondent/CMDC is ready for settling the dispute by way of mediation, to which, Mr. Ashish Shrivastava, learned Senior Counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that respondent/CMDC has objected and not ready to go for the mediation, because of the matter is subjudiced before this Court. He further pointed out that an auction notice has also been issued on 19.12.2025, which is fixed for tomorrow (,i.e, 07.01.2026), therefore, same may be stayed. In view of above facts and submissions, parties are directed to settle their dispute by means of mediation in terms of the Clause 20 of the Agreement. Till the mediation is completed between the parties, if any such auction is conducted, it will be subject to decision of this Court.
