19/03/2026	Heard Mr. Manoj Kumar Jaiswal, learned counsel for the applicant. Also heard Ms. Ritika Verma, learned Panel Lawyer appearing for the Non-applicant/State, as well as Mr. Ashutosh Singh Kachhawaha, learned counsel appearing for the Directorate of Revenue Intelligence (DRI). From perusal of the present bail application, it transpires that the Union of India, through the Directorate of Revenue Intelligence, has not been arrayed as a party Non-applicant and instead, the State of Chhattisgarh has been arrayed as the Non-Applicant. Learned counsel for the applicant prays for permission to implead the necessary party and has filed I.A. No. 2/2026 for the said purpose.

On due consideration, the aforesaid application is **allowed.**

Learned counsel for the applicant is directed to carry out necessary correction and implead the Union of India, through the Directorate of Revenue Intelligence, Raipur, as party Non-applicant in place of the State of Chhattisgarh in the bail application during the course of the day.

Two weeks' time is granted to the newly impleaded Non-applicant to file reply and one week's time thereafter is granted to the applicant to file rejoinder.

List this matter immediately thereafter.
