1. Heard.
2. This writ petition has been preferred by the petitioner under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, seeking following reliefs:-

“10.1 The Hon'ble Court may kindly be pleased to direct the respondents to make proper arrangement for drainage and prevent the discharge of Sewage Water into the Lakes of Naraiya.

10.2 The Hon'ble Court may kindly be pleased to direct the Respondents for construction of proper drainage



system for the subject lake and ensure the sewage does not enter the lakes, with storm water drains.

10.3 The Hon'ble Court may kindly be pleased to direct the respondents to provide for a sewage treatment plant so that the sewage water can be treated before discharging it in the subject lakes or any water body.

10.4 Cost of the petition may also be granted to the petitioner.

10.5 Any other relief, which this Hon'ble Court deems fit and proper, may also kindly be granted to the petitioner, in the interest of justice."

3. Learned counsel appearing for the respondents No.3 & 5 submits that the grievance of the petitioner is being redressed by the authorities concerned in near future as per instructions received by the authorities concerned.
4. In view of the above submission made by the counsel appearing for the respondents No.3 & 5, this Court does not consider present to be a fit case for further adjudication of this Case, as the grievance of the petitioner is likely to be redressed, as stated by the counsel for the respondent No.3 & 5. Accordingly, this petition is disposed of on the basis of aforesaid statement made at Bar.
5. However, respondents No.3 & 5 are directed to comply the order dated 05.03.2024 in its later and spirit till 15.04.2026.
6. With the aforesaid direction, the instant writ petition stands disposed of.
7. Interlocutory application(s), pending if any, also stands disposed of.
