**HON'BLE SHRI JUSTICE PARTH PRATEEM SAHU****Order on Board****16/03/2026**

1. Petitioner has filed this writ petition seeking following reliefs;

“10.1 That this Hon'ble Court may kindly be pleased to call for entire records pertaining to the case of petitioners for kind perusal of this Hon'ble court.

10.2 That this Hon'ble Court may kindly be pleased to quash the impugned transfer order 15/09/2025 (Annexure P-1) and direct the respondent No. 4 not to disturb the petitioner and take back to Dongargarh, Rajnandgaon.

10.3 Any other relief, which may be deemed, fit by this Hon'ble Court just and proper in the facts and circumstances of the case may also be provided in favour of the petitioner.”

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he is not pressing this writ petition on merits, however, he is only seeking a direction to respondent No. 2 and 4 to consider and take decision on the representation submitted by the petitioner, at the earliest, within specified time frame.
3. Counsel for the State submits that in view of the limited prayer made by counsel for the petitioner, he is having no objection.
4. On due consideration of submission of counsel for the parties, the writ petition, at this stage, is disposed of permitting the petitioner to submit fresh comprehensive representation before respondent No. 2 and 4, and if such a representation is submitted, the concerned authorities shall consider and take decision, in accordance with law, expeditiously, preferably within a period of three months from the date of receipt of the representation.
5. With the aforesaid observation and direction, the writ petition is disposed of.
