17/03/2026	Mr. Jitendra Pali, counsel for petitioner. Mr. Yashwant Singh Thakur, Additional A.G. for State-respondents. Heard. Learned counsel for petitioner submits that petitioner was issued show cause notice on 09.01.2026 alleging that the road which was constructed from Damkasa (Kanker) to Petechua about 6.80 KM length is of sub-standard. During course of construction of road, petitioner has not properly supervise the work and 70% of the road has been damaged. Petitioner submitted reply to the notice on 23.01.2025 within a period as provided in the show cause notice, however, before the reply is received, the order of suspension of petitioner has been passed. He also contended that petitioner in site order book has given direction time to time to contractor for proper construction of road and according to petitioner till date, the amount for

construction of road has not been released in favour of contractor, therefore, there is no loss to the government exchequer.

In the aforementioned facts of the case, State counsel is directed to verify as to whether the cost of work, which is subject matter of notice is released in favour of contractor or not and if not released then to make submission as to on whose objection, cost of amount due to contractor towards work done is not released.

List this case after two weeks.
