17/03/2026	Heard Mr. Pravin Kumar Tulsyan, learned counsel, appearing for the applicant. Also heard Ms. Nitansh Jaiswal, learned Panel Lawyer, appearing for the non - applicant/State. Though the bail application of the other co-accused, namely, Shankar Chhatra, which was also listed before this Court today, has been rejected considering the quantity of contraband, <i>i.e.</i>, 50.100 kg of ganja, it is submitted by learned counsel for the applicant that the present applicant, namely, N. Subhash, who is in custody since 14.09.2024, is suffering from loss of memory and has also sustained injuries on his person. He further submits that, despite filing an RTI application, he was unable to obtain the medical report of the applicant.



In view of the aforesaid, the concerned Jail Superintendent is directed to inform this Court regarding the health condition and ailments of the applicant, as stated, and to file a personal affidavit in this regard.

Learned State Counsel is directed to communicate this order to the concerned Jail Superintendent for necessary information and compliance forthwith.

Let the matter be listed again after two weeks.
