Learned counsel for the respondents accept notice on behalf of their respective respondents, hence, issuance of notice to them is dispensed with. Also heard on IA No.01/2026, application for grant of interim relief and stay. Learned Sr. counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that vide Order dated 29.10.2025 (Annexure – P/1), Commissioner, Raipur Division, Raipur has passed an order, whereby easementary right has been granted in favour of the

Bini	petitioner. Despite that, respondent No.2 is raising construction of smart toilet, hence, interim protection may be granted to the petitioner. In reply, learned counsel for respondent No.2 submits that easementary right has been granted to the petitioner by the Commissioner only in respect of petitioner's own land. However, the petitioner himself has constructed the house in deviation from the approved map. He further submits that in this regard, the Municipal Corporation has issued notice to the petitioner, hence, interim protection may not be granted to the petitioner. Having considered the contention put forth by learned counsel for the parties, this Court is not inclined to grant any interim protection to the petitioner. However, two weeks time is granted to learned counsel for the respondents to file reply to IA No.01/2026 as well as to the main petition. Sd/- (Naresh Kumar Chandravanshi) Judge
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
