No. 01/2026 application for grant of stay.</p> <p>It has been submitted by the learned counsel for the petitioners that there is no specific allegation that has been leveled against the present Petitioners who is the husband and in-laws of respondent No.2. He further submitted that the petitioners have been alleged in the aforesaid offence U/s-296, 351(2), 351(3), 115(2), 84, 74, 3(5) of BNS 2023 with the ulterior motive to falsely implicate the husband and whole family members. He also submits that the complaint does not disclose specific dates, times, place or overt acts attributable to each accused, all the allegations are general and sweeping in nature, made collectively against all accused, which is impermissible in law.</p> <p>Considering the fact that the dispute arrived at between the parties is matrimonial in nature, we deem it appropriate to make an effort to get the said dispute settled by way of mediation.</p> <p>In view of the above, petitioner No.1, husband is</p> |
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directed to deposit a sum of Rs.50,000/- with the Mediation Centre of this Court within a period of one week from today and the same shall be paid to respondent No.2/ complainant on her appearance before the Mediation Centre.

Parties are directed to appear before the Mediation Centre of this Court on **15.04.2026**.

Learned State counsel is directed to inform the private respondent *i.e.* respondent No. 2 about passing of this order, so that she may appear before the Mediation Centre on the aforesaid date.

List this matter along with report of Mediation Centre before this Court on **23.04.2026**.

Till then, the further criminal proceedings in Criminal Case No. 10611/2025 pending before the Court of Judicial Magistrate First Class, Korba shall remain stayed.

The petitioners are directed to produce the copy of the receipt before the concerned trial Court regarding

payment of the said money before the Mediation Centre of this Court in pursuance of this Court's order, then only this order shall be given into effect.

It is also made clear that if any final settlement is arrived at between the parties, the aforesaid amount so deposited, shall be adjusted.
