23.04.2026	Heard Mr. Sachin Nidhi (through video conferencing), learned counsel for the petitioner. Also heard Ms. Anusha Naik, learned Deputy Government Advocate, appearing for respondent No.1/State. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that this Court, vide order dated 01.04.2026, was pleased to refer the matter to mediation before the Mediation Centre on 15.04.2026 and had directed the petitioner to deposit a sum of Rs. 50,000/- to be paid to respondent No. 2 during the course of mediation proceedings. It is further submitted that, due to certain unavoidable circumstances, the petitioner could not deposit the said amount within the stipulated time, and therefore, a prayer is made for grant of reasonable extension of time to comply with the said direction so as to enable meaningful

participation in the mediation process and to explore the possibility of an amicable settlement between the parties.

In view of the prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner, parties are directed to appear before the Mediation Centre of this Court on **05.05.2026**.

Learned State counsel is directed to inform the private respondent No.2 about passing of this order, so that she may appear before the Mediation Centre of the aforesaid date.

List this matter along with report of Mediation Centre before this Court on **12.05.2026**.

Interim relief if any shall continue till the next date of hearing.
