1. The petitioner has filed this writ petition seeking following reliefs:-

*"10.1 That, this Hon'ble Court may kindly be
pleased to issue a writ in the nature of mandamus
quashing the impugned show-cause notices dated
02.02.2026 and 08.02.2026 (Annexure P/1) issued
by the Respondent No.3..*

*10.2 That, this Hon'ble Court may kindly be
pleased to restrain the respondents from initiating*



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continuing any disciplinary proceedings against the petitioner pursuant to the impugned notices dated 02.02.2026 and 08.02.2026.

10.3 That, this Hon'ble Court may kindly be pleased to direct the respondents to ensure protection of the petitioner from any further victimisation in connection with complaints made regarding financial irregularities.

10.4 That, the Hon'ble Court may kindly be pleased to grant any other relief, as it may deem-fit and appropriate."

2. On the objection being raised by the counsel for petitioner with regard to maintainability of the writ petition at this stage on the ground that the challenge in this writ petition is to the letter/notice seeking explanation from the petitioner only, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he may be permitted to withdraw this writ petition with liberty to repeat the prayer if any exigency so arises in future.
3. In view of the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner, this writ petition is **dismissed as withdrawn** with liberty as prayed for.
