21/01/2025	Mr. Hardeep Singh Rajpur, Petitioner in person. Mr. Navoday Singh, on behalf of Mr. Yashwant Singh Thakur, learned counsel for Respondents No. 1 to 3. Mr. Pankaj Agrawal, learned counsel for respondent No. 2. The instant contempt petition has been filed by the petitioner herein, alleging non-compliance of this Court's order dated 17.01.2023 passed in WPC No. 2137 of 2022. The observing part of the said order is reproduced hereinunder:- <i>"Given the aforesaid factual matrix of the case, particularly, taking note of the order of the Board of Revenue dated 16.04.2018, whereby the order passed by the Tahsildar Korba and the Sub Divisional Officer Korba in a proceeding under Section 250 of Chhattisgarh Land Revenue Code so far as removal of illegal encroachment is concerned, this Court is of the opinion that the present Writ Petition at this juncture can be disposed of directing the Respondent No. 1, 2 & 3 to take appropriate steps ensuring that the order of Board of Revenue dated 16.04.2018, subject to verification of facts and also the orders dated 09.06.2014 and 20.04.2016 were passed by the Tahsildar and Sub Division Officer in the proceedings under Section 250 of the Chhattisgarh Land Revenue Code, is complied with</i>
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in its letter and spirit in accordance with law within an outer limit of 60 days."

Petitioner in person contended the order of this Court has not been complied with.

Learned counsel for the respondent No. 2 would contend that encroachment (Road and Nali) has been removed by the respondent No. 2.

Learned counsel for respondent No. 1 & 3 would submit that affidavit could not be filed due to nomination proceeding and he prays for two weeks' time to file affidavit in detail.

As prayed for two weeks' time is granted, failing which respondent No. 1 & 3 shall remain present before this Court on the next date of hearing.

Also heard I.A. No. 04 application for impleading appropriate parties in the present petition.

Petitioner in person contend that the respondent No. 2-Commissioner has been transferred at Korba, therefore prays for impleadment of newly posted Commissioner.

On due consideration I.A. No. 04/2024 stands allowed.

Let necessary amendment be carried out within one week.

After amendment, issue notice to the newly added respondent No. 2 on payment of P.F. as per rules.

List this case on 25.02.2025.
