1. The petitioner has filed this petition seeking the following relief(s):-

"10.1 That, the Hon'ble Court may kindly be pleased to issue a writ/ writs, order/ orders, direction/ directions to the respondent authorities and the appointment order of the respondent no. 5 on the post of Assistant Veterinary field officer, dated 10.12.2021 (Anne. P-8) may kindly be cancelled.



10.2 That, the Hon'ble Court may kindly be pleased to issue a writ/writs, order/orders, direction/directions to the respondent authorities to consider the case of the petitioner for appointment on the post of Assistant Veterinary field officer, in pursuance to the advertisement dated 07.10.2021 (Anne. P-3), in the interest of justice.

10.3 That, the Hon'ble Court may kindly be pleased to issue a writ/writs order/orders, direction/directions to the respondent no. 3 to consider the objection as raised by the petitioner, objectively, and to take appropriate action against the respondent no. 5 in the interest of justice.

10.4 Any other relief which this Hon'ble Court deems fit and proper."
