Prajapati, Counsel for the Petitioner.</p> <p>Ms. Sunita Jain, G.A. for the State.</p> <p>Heard.</p> <p>Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner was in possession of the disputed land but Respondent No. 6 filed an revision before the Board of Revenue without incorporating the petitioner as party and the orders were passed on 04.07.2018 (Annexure P-1) by the Board of Revenue. He further submits that the documents would show that the petitioner is in possession of the subject land. It is further submitted that the said order was passed behind the back of the petitioner though the interest of the petitioner was involved.</p> <p>Issue notice to the Respondent No. 6, as per rules.</p> <p>Perusal of the documents, <i>prima facie</i> shows that the petitioner is in possession of the subject land and he was not a party before the Board of Revenue. Considering the same, it is directed that status quo in respect of possession of the land shall</p>

be maintained, till the next date of hearing.

List the case after 6 weeks.
