No. 702/2025 submits that since he has received the paper book today itself, these matters may be listed for hearing day after tomorrow.</p> <p>Since the appellants have been convicted for possessing 1533 KG and 791 grams of contraband Ganja which is much</p>			



above the commercial quantity, and further that the appellants are in jail since 05.01.2021, we deem it appropriate to reject the applications for suspension of sentence and grant of bail to the applicants at this stage and hear the matter finally on merits.
