16/03/2026	Mr. Raj Kumar Pali, Advocate for the petitioner. Heard on I.A. No.01/2026, an application for grant of interim relief/ stay. By the present transfer petition, the petitioner seeks transfer of Divorce Case No. CS-A/1124/2025, pending before the learned 3rd Additional Principal Judge, Family Court, Durg to the learned Principal Judge, Family Court, Bemetara. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the marriage between the petitioner and the respondent was solemnized on 22.04.2023. He further submits that the respondent has filed an application under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 before the Family Court, Durg. It is further submitted that the petitioner is

presently residing at her parental house with her minor child aged about 1.5 years; and faces considerable difficulty in travelling to Durg due to the long distance involved.

In view of the above, issue notice to the respondent, by ordinary as well as registered post.

Process fee be paid within 10 days.

Considering the entire facts and circumstances of the case, further proceedings with respect to the Divorce Case No. CS-A/1124/2025 filed under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 pending before the learned 3rd Additional Principal Judge, Family Court, Durg, shall remain stayed, till the next date of hearing.

Accordingly, I.A. No.1 is hereby disposed of.
