1. Petitioner has filed this writ petition seeking following reliefs.



“10.1 That, this Hon’ble Court may kindly be pleased to issue a writ of mandamus directing the respondent authorities to correct the gradation list of the petitioner and consider the petitioner seniority w.e.f. 17.08.2007 ie., the date of appointment and provide further consequential benefits like promotion to higher post.

10.2 That, this Hon’ble Court may kindly be pleased to grant any other relief as it may deem fit and appropriate.”

2. After arguing for sometime, counsel for petitioner submits that as petitioner has already submitted representation on 12.01.2026 before Respondent No. 6-District Education Officer, which is pending consideration, therefore, direction be issued to the concerned authority to take decision on pending representation at the earliest within specified time frame.
3. Learned counsel for State submits that in view of limited prayer made by learned counsel for petitioner, she is having no objection.
4. On due consideration of submission made by learned counsel for respective parties, without commenting any thing on the merits of the case, I find it appropriate to dispose of this writ petition at this stage directing Respondent No. 6-District Education Officer to consider and take decision on pending representation of petitioner, in accordance with law, expeditiously, preferably within a further period of 04 months from the date of receipt of the order passed by this Court.
5. With the aforesaid observation and direction, this writ petition is disposed of.
