20/03/2026	Mr. Rajendra Patel, learned counsel for the petitioner. Mr. Ashutosh Trivedi, Panel Lawyer appearing for the respondent No.4. Issue notice to the respondents No. 1(a) to 1(e), 2 and 3 on payment of process fee by ordinary as well as speed post mode both. Process fee be paid within 7 days. Also heard on I.A. No. 1/2026 which is an application for grant of stay. Learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that the application of the petitioner under Order 7 Rule 14 of CPC as well as Order 13 Rule 10 of CPC has been rejected by the learned trial Court holding that it has been filed belatedly, however, the occasion arises only after filing of the document by the defendant which was allowed on 02.02.2026. He would further submit that the document filed

by the petitioner is very relevant for just decision of the case.

The suit pertains to declaration of title and possession and in absence of the documents filed by the petitioner, proper adjudication of the dispute between the parties would be affected.

Considering the submissions made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, purely as an interim measure, the further proceeding of the Civil Suit No. 68/2019 pending before the Civil Judge, Senior Division, Gharghoda, District – Raigarh shall remained stayed till the next date of hearing.

It is made clear that if the petitioner fails to pay the process fee as ordered by this Court, the petition shall automatically dismissed without reference to defence.
