2. The present petition has been filed by the petitioner under Article
 226 of the Constitution of India with the following prayers :-



“10.1 To call for entire records from respondents pertaining to petitioners leave case for kind perusal of the Hon’ble High Court.

10.2 To quash impugned memo dated 05.01.2026 (Annexure P-1) and also to direct respondents to release petitioner on parole under the Chhattisgarh Prisoner’s Leave Rules 1989.

10.4 To grant any other relief deemed fit and proper in facts and circumstances of the case.”
