1. The present MCC has been registered on the basis of a request letter (PUD) dated 26.02.2026, seeking extension of time for deciding Claim Case No. 542/2016 (N.R. Pillai v. Nemichand & others) and for compliance of the order dated 21.08.2025 passed in MCC No. 852/2025.
2. It appears from the said request letter that earlier directions were issued by this Court for expeditious disposal of the claim case by the orders passed on 13.12.2024 in WP227 No. 943/2024 and WP227 No. 867/2023. Pursuant thereto, this Court, while deciding MCC No. 852/2025, had already granted an extension of six months' time for disposal of the claim case.
3. The present request has been made seeking further extension of time on the grounds stated in the communication. Considering the reasons assigned in the request letter and the facts and circumstances of the case, this Court finds it

appropriate to grant a further extension.

4. Accordingly, a further period of three months from the date of communication of this order is granted to the concerned authority/Court to finally decide Claim Case No. 542/2016.
5. Ordered accordingly.
6. With the aforesaid direction, the present MCC stands disposed of.
