learned Family Court, Bilaspur (C.G.), wherein the next date of hearing is fixed on 23.03.2026. It is submitted that the applicant is residing at Korba and is taking care of her minor female child aged about 18 months, who is suffering from epilepsy, due to which it is extremely difficult for her to travel to Bilaspur, which is about 120 kms away.

It is further submitted that the petitioner has already initiated proceedings under Section 144 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 before the learned Family Court, Korba, and therefore, for the sake of convenience and in the interest of justice, the present case is liable to be transferred to Family Court, Korba. It is thus prayed that further proceedings before the Family Court, Bilaspur be stayed till decision of the present transfer petition.
