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Ld. State counsel accepts notice on behalf of Respondents, hence, PF is not required to be paid. He prays for and is granted three weeks' time to file reply.

Also heard on I.A. No. 01/2026, application for grant of interim relief.

Learned counsel for petitioner submits that petitioner had challenged the order of his transfer dated 08.03.2019 in WPS No. 2603/2019, which was disposed of with an observation that the order dated 08.03.2019 shall not be acted upon and petitioner be permitted to work on the earlier place of posting for a period of three months and further direction was issued to take fresh decision with regard to transfer of petitioner. Order is passed prior to passing of period of 03 months and however respondent-department has acted upon the earlier order of transfer dated 08.03.2019 and maintained his transfer rejecting the representation, which is in contravention of order passed in writ petition.

Learned State counsel submits that the order is passed complying the directives issued by the High Court and its order dated 18.11.2025. He however submits that he will file reply to the application for grant of interim relief also.

On due consideration of the submission of learned counsel for the respective parties, purely as an interim measure, it is
