27/06/2023	Mr. Akash Kumar Kundu, counsel for the appellant. Mr. Aman Kesharwani, P.L. for the State. State counsel is directed to inform the complainant/victim for his appearance before this Court either in person or through his counsel or through Video Conferencing with the aid of the concerned District Legal Services Authority. Heard on I.A. No.01/2023, application for grant of stay. Counsel for the appellant submits that the case is fixed for defence evidence before the trial Court on 07.07.2023 and there is possibility of closing the defence evidence. He also submits that the agreement dated 19.06.2008 was examined by private hand writing expert through xerox copy (Ex.P-4) and the accused has already submitted the original copy of agreement before the trial Court along with application to examine the signature of witness in original agreement which was dismissed. Therefore, it is prayed that the interim application may be allowed otherwise, the right of accused to put his defence will be prejudiced. Counsel for the State opposes the submission made by learned counsel for the appellant.
