ORDER ON BOARD

1. The petitioner has filed this writ petition seeking following reliefs.
 - “10.1 This Hon'ble Court may kindly be pleased to direct the respondent authorities to produce entire records pertaining to instant matter.
 - 10.2 This Hon'ble Court may kindly be pleased to Issue an appropriate writ, order or direction, particularly in the nature of Writ of Mandamus, directing the respondents to consider and decide the petitioner's representation dated 24/02/2026 (Annexure P/1) in a time-bound manner;
 - 10.3 This Hon'ble Court may kindly be pleased to Issue an appropriate writ, order or direction directing the respondents to restore and continue the family pension of the petitioner's children, which has been illegally stopped.
 - 10.4 This Hon'ble Court may kindly be pleased to Further direct the respondents to release the arrears of family pension of the petitioner's children along with interest, from the date it was stopped till actual payment.
 - 10.5 This Hon'ble Court may kindly be pleased to Issue an appropriate writ, order or direction declaring the action of the respondents in stopping the family pension of the petitioner's children as illegal, arbitrary and unconstitutional.
 - 10.6 Pass any other order or direction as this Hon'ble Court may deem fit and proper in the facts and circumstances of the case, in the interest of justice.”
2. At the outset, counsel for the counsel for the petitioner submits that at this stage he is not pressing this petition on merits and is only seeking a direction to the Treasury Officer, Bilaspur to consider and take decision on Annexure-P/1 dated 24.02.2026, at the earliest, within specified time frame.
3. Counsel for the State submits that in view of the limited prayer made by counsel for the petitioner, he is having no objection.



4. On due consideration of the submissions made by learned counsel for the parties, the writ petition at this stage is disposed of directing the Senior Treasury Officer, District: Bilaspur to consider and take decision on the representation Annexure-P/1 dated 24.02.2026, in accordance with law, expeditiously, preferably within a further period of six weeks from the date of receipt of copy of the representation.
5. Accordingly, this writ petition is disposed of with the aforesaid observation and direction.
