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the marriage of the younger brother of the applicant is scheduled tomorrow, i.e. 26.03.2026, he is the only male member other than his younger brother, as his father had died long back, and according to rituals elder brother is the father, and his presence is necessary to perform the marriage rituals. He annexed a marriage card with the application to this effect; therefore, the applicant may be granted interim bail for three days to perform the marriage ceremony.

Learned State counsel opposes the interim bail application.

In view of the submissions made by the counsel for the parties and considering the fact that the second bail application of the applicant has been rejected on merit on 07.01.2026 in MCRC No. 60/2026 by this Court, the applicant has six criminal antecedents, I do not find it a fit case to grant interim bail to the applicant.

Accordingly, I.A. No. 01/2026, application for interim relief/bail is **rejected**.
