

**HIGH COURT OF CHHATTISGARH AT BILASPUR****TPC No. 49 of 2026****ANUJA YADAV *versus* RAMKUMAR YADAV****Order Sheet**

25/03/2026	Shri Anmol Sharma, learned counsel for the petitioner. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner on the (I.A. No. 01/2026) application for grant of stay in the present transfer petition. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner/wife has been constrained to file the present transfer petition seeking transfer of proceedings arising out of Case No. 392/2025 filed

under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, which is presently pending before the learned Family Court, Raipur (C.G.). It is submitted that the petitioner is residing at Durg with her parental family, having no independent source of income, and is entirely dependent upon her parents for her livelihood. It is further submitted that the petitioner has been subjected to continuous mental and physical harassment by the respondent/husband and his family members on account of dowry demands, and is also deprived of the custody of her minor child.

It is further submitted that multiple proceedings between the same parties, including proceedings under Section 144 BNSS as well as proceedings under the Domestic Violence Act, are already pending before the competent Courts at Durg, wherein the respondent/husband has been

appearing. It is contended that despite having knowledge of such circumstances, the respondent has instituted the proceedings under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act at Raipur with the sole intention to harass the petitioner and to cause inconvenience to her.

Learned counsel further submits that considering the financial constraints of the petitioner, the distance between Durg and Raipur, lack of proper conveyance, and absence of any male member to accompany her, it is extremely difficult for the petitioner to attend the proceedings at Raipur. It is also apprehended that her safety may be at risk due to the conduct of the respondent and his family members.

Considering the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner, the facts and

circumstances of the case, particularly the financial hardship faced by the petitioner, pendency of connected matters at Durg, and the inconvenience and difficulty in attending the proceedings at Raipur, this Court finds it appropriate to grant interim protection.

Accordingly, it is directed that further proceedings of Case No. 392/2025 pending before the learned Family Court, Raipur (C.G.) shall remain stayed till the next date of hearing.

Issue notice to the respondent on payment of process fee within a period of ten days.

List this case after service of notice to the respondent.
