24/03/2026	Ms. Shivali Dubey, counsel for the petitioner. Mr. Shobhit Mishra, Dy. Govt. Advocate for the State/ respondents 1 to 5. Heard. Issue notice to the respondents. Learned counsel for the State accepts notice on behalf of respondents 1 to 5, hence, issuance of notice to them is
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dispensed with.

PF be paid within a week for issuance of notice to respondent No.6.

Also heard on IA No.01/2026, application for interim relief.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is a landless person, who has constructed a house on Government land bearing Khasra No.579 situated at village Chingri, Distt. Durg (CG) and has been residing there for more than 15 years. However, respondent No.6 has issued eviction notice. She further submits that respondent No.6 has further issued notice dated 24.02.2026 for removal of encroachment, failing which, the same will be demolished on 25.3.2026. The said notice has been received by the petitioner today only. Hence, she prays that interim protection may be granted.

In reply, learned counsel for the State submits that since the petitioner has encroached upon the Government land, therefore, proceedings have been initiated against him. However, he submits that respondent No.6/Sarpach, Gram Panchayat, Village Chingri is the main contesting party in this petition.

In view of the above contention of learned counsel for the parties, purely as an interim measure, it is directed that effect and operation of impugned notice dated 28.06.2023 (Annexure-P/1) and notice dated 24.02.2026 issued by respondent No.6, which is directed to be filed through covering memo, shall remain stayed till the next date of hearing.

Bini	Learned counsel for the petitioner as well as the State counsel are directed to inform respondent No.6/competent authority regarding this order. Learned counsel for the State is further directed to inform respondent No.6 to present before this Court along with minutes of meeting register of village Panchayat Chingri, on the next date of hearing.
