Since the defendant evidence has not been started yet, the applicant's application may be allowed. On due consideration, purely as an interim measure, further proceedings of the Civil Suit No 231-A/2025, pending before the learned Family Court, Raigarh, shall remain stayed till the next date of hearing.
