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| 20/04/2026 | <p>Heard Mr. Aniruddh Singh, learned counsel for the applicant.</p> <p>Learned counsel for the applicant submits that the applicant, who is the wife of respondent No.1 has been denied maintenance by the Family Court on the ground that the applicant has kept a woman in a live-in relationship to take care of his mother and her maintenance is being met from his income as well as the pension received by his mother, which is absolutely erroneous and cannot be sustained. He further submits that the maintenance of respondent No.2 (Deepkumar Sahu) has been rejected on the ground that he has</p> |
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already attained majority and applicant No.3 (Ms. Jigyasa Sahu, minor daughter) has been granted Rs.2,000/- per month as maintenance.

In view of the same, let a notice be issued to the respondent No.1/ husband through concerned Superintendent of Police by speed post mode, making it returnable on or before 6<sup>th</sup> May, 2026. Steps be taken within a week.

List the matter on 6<sup>th</sup> May, 2026.
