

**HIGH COURT OF CHHATTISGARH AT BILASPUR****MCRC No. 3403 of 2026****Santuram Kamar *Versus* State Of Chhattisgarh****Order Sheet**

15/04/2026	Ms. Smriti Shrivastava, learned Panel Lawyer appearing for the Non-applicant/State is present. When the matter was called for hearing, Mr. Anway Tiwari, learned counsel for the applicants, did not appear. Information was conveyed to him by Mr. Nitansh Kumar Jaiswal, learned State counsel, whereafter Mr. Raj Singhale, Advocate, appeared on his behalf. Mr. Raj Singhale, learned counsel submitted that Mr. Anway Tiwari as well as Mr. Satish Surya are out of station due to personal reasons and prayed for adjournment. It is brought to the notice of this Court that vide order dated 24.03.2026 passed in MCRC No. 1733 of 2026, this Court had already granted bail to the
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applicants namely Santuram Kamar and Ramcharan Kamar. Despite the same, the present bail application has been filed again on behalf of the said applicants.

It is further noted that in both the earlier bail application as well as the present bail application, the deponent is the same person, namely Sundar Kamar.

On a pointed query being made by this Court as to how the present bail application has been filed on behalf of the applicants despite the fact that they have already been granted bail by this Court on 24.03.2026, learned counsel Mr. Raj Singhale, submitted that he has no knowledge regarding the same.

In view of the aforesaid, let notice be issued to the deponent, namely Sundar Kamar, to show cause as to why proceedings for forgery and contempt of Court be not initiated against him, inasmuch as he has filed the present bail application along with an affidavit in support thereof, whereas an earlier bail application was already filed on behalf of the applicants on 10.02.2026 through learned counsel Mr. Virendra Kashyap, wherein also he himself was the deponent.



Accordingly, Mr. Anway Tiwari is directed to explain the aforesaid facts.

Let notice be issued to the deponent through the Registrar (Judicial) for his appearance, either in person or through counsel, on the next date of hearing.
