The applicants have preferred this First Bail Application under Section 483 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (for short 'BNSS'), for grant of regular bail, as they have been arrested in connection with Crime No. 12/2026, registered at Police Station Khallari, District - Mahasamund (C.G.) for the offence punishable under Section 34(2) of Chhattisgarh Excise Act.
2. Learned counsel for the applicants submits that he does not wish



to press the present bail application, as the applicants have already been granted bail by this Court on 24.03.2026 passed in MCRC No. 1733/2026. He further states that the deponent, namely Sundar Kamar, has filed an affidavit in compliance with the notice issued to him by this Court vide order dated 15.04.2026.

3. In view of the submission made by learned counsel for the applicants, the instant bail application is **dismissed** as **withdrawn** with caution to the applicants that they shall not repeat such act in future.
