1. By way of this petition, the petitioner has prayed for following reliefs:-

"10.1 That, this Hon'ble Court may be kind enough in issuing a writ in the nature of mandamus, certiorari or likewise any other appropriate writ, order or commands, commanding and directing the respondents to place the complete records related with the case of the petitioners for just and proper decision of the case.

10.2 That, this Hon'ble Court may be kind enough in issuing a writ in the nature of mandamus, certiorari or likewise any other appropriate writ, order or commands, commanding to quash the order dated 23.12.2021 passed by respondent no.2, untenable in the eyes of law pass an order to grant permission to the permission in due accordance with laws as restrictions not apply for diverted land.

10.3 That, this Hon'ble Court may also be pleased to issue That. this Hon'ble Court may be kind enough in issuing a writ in the nature of mandamus, certiorari or likewise any other appropriate writ, order or commands, commanding and directing the respondents direct all the legal action against the person who have not discharge their responsibility as per the provisions and requirements of the law of the land.

10.4 That, this Hon'ble Court may also be pleased to issue That, this Hon'ble Court may be kind enough in issuing a writ in the nature of mandamus, certiorari or



likewise any other appropriate writ, order or commands, commanding and directing the respondent state to consider the matter of the petitioner and also direct respondent no. 2 to conclude the matter expeditiously as the petitioners required money to sustain their livelihood.

10.5 Any other relief, That, this Hon'ble Court may be kind enough in issuing a writ in the nature of mandamus, certiorari or likewise any other appropriate writ, order or commands, commanding and directing the respondents which the Hon'ble Court deems fit and proper looking to the facts and circumstances of the case, may also be granted.”

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner after arguing for some time seeks permission of this Court to withdraw this petition.
3. No objection has been raised from other side.
4. Accordingly, the writ petition is dismissed as withdrawn.
