2. The present petition has been filed by the petitioners under Section 528 of the Bhartiya Nagrik Suraksha Sanhita with the following prayers :-

Hon'ble Court may kindly be pleased to allow the petition and quash the registration of FIR No. 0488/2025 lodged in P.S. Ambikapur, District- Sarguja (C.G.) dated 22.07.2025, along with Chargesheet No. 550/2025 dated 24.10.2025, taking cognizance of alleged offences u/s 384, 420 of IPC dated 29.12.2025 in Criminal Case No. 11555 of 2025 pending in the Court of learned JMFC, Ambikapur, District – Sarguja (C.G.), in the interest of justice.

On a pointed query being made from learned counsel for the petitioner as to what is the status of the present case as the order taking cognizance has been passed way back on 29.12.2025 and why he has not filed the present order sheet of the trial Court, he submits that he may be allowed time to file the same.
