1. This acquittal appeal has been preferred by the appellant against the impugned judgment of acquittal dated 15.03.2019 passed by learned Sessions Judge, Kawardha, District- Kabeerdham (C.G.) in case of "State of Chhattisgarh Vs. Parmeshwar Dhurve, whereby the

accused/respondent No.2 has been acquitted of the charge under Section 302 of IPC. Hence, this appeal.

2. At the very outset, learned counsel for the appellant submits that appellant died on 30.03.2024 and he has filed the death certificate issued by the competent authority on 23.04.2024.
