Learned counsel for the appellants would submit that the learned trial court has dismissed the suit filed by the plaintiff against which the plaintiff has filed the first appeal before the learned 3rd Additional District Judge who in turn by judgment and decree dated 9-1-2019 has allowed the appeal and set aside the judgment and decree passed by the learned trial court passed on 8-5-2018. He would further submit that the appellants are residing with their families in the suit accommodation since 1988-89 and there is no other accommodation available. The appeal is admitted on the following question of law. “Whether the learned First Appellate Court was justified in reversing the well reasoned finding recorded by the learned trial Court with regard to issue No.1 ie., the suit land purchased from the income of the joint property is contrary to the record?. Since all the respondents are represented through their counsel, no notice is required to be issued. List this case after six weeks.
