Shri Jitendra Pali, Deputy Advocate General, accepts notice on behalf of all the respondents, hence issuance of notice stands dispensed with. Also heard on IA No.1 which is an application for stay of the proceedings. Considering the fact that disciplinary proceeding has been initiated at the behest of the Lok Ayog and on perusal of report of the Lok Ayog (Annexure P/5), it reflects that Lok Ayog on an enquiry had found that certain senior level officers in the department were also involved in the said charge and the Lok Ayog had recommended for initiating action against them, but according to the petitioner, the State Govt. has not initiated any steps against that high level officers and have only initiated steps against the employees and officers in the lower cadre. Given the facts, let reply to IA No.1 be also filed within a period of four weeks from today.
