Learned counsel for the applicant submits that the present bail application has become infructuous, as the applicant has already been granted bail by the learned trial Court yesterday. This Court is constrained to observe that it is indeed unfortunate that after the rejection of the bail application by the concerned trial Court on 13.10.2025, the present application was filed before this Court and during its pendency, the bail appears to have been filed again before the trial Court and the same has been granted by the trial Court.



Kunal	Under such circumstances, this Court deems it appropriate to call for comments from the concerned trial Court as to under what circumstances the bail was granted to the applicant. In view of the above, the Principal District & Sessions Judge, Bilaspur (C.G.) is directed to call for an explanation from the concerned trial Judge and place the same before this Court today itself by 03:00 P.M and the matter be listed again after recess. The Registrar (Judicial) is directed to communicate the passing of this order to the Principal District & Sessions Judge, Bilaspur for necessary information and compliance forthwith.
