Hon'ble Shri Ramesh Sinha, Chief Justice**Order On Board****23.04.2026**

1. The applicant has preferred this application under Section 482 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 for grant of Anticipatory Bail, apprehending his arrest in connection with Crime No. 586/2025, registered at Police Station – Basantpur, District – Rajnandgaon (C.G.) for alleged commission of offence punishable under Sections 34(2) of the C.G. Excise Act and Section 111 of the BNS.
2. Learned State counsel raised a preliminary objection regarding the maintainability of the present anticipatory bail application as the same is not maintainable in view of the provisions contained in Section 59-A of the Chhattisgarh Excise Act, and submits that therefore, the present anticipatory bail application of the applicant is liable to be rejected on this ground alone.



3. I have heard learned counsel for the parties and perused the material available on record.
4. Learned counsel for the applicants could not waive out the preliminary objection raised by the learned State counsel, hence, the present anticipatory bail application of the applicant – **Paramjeet Singh @ Pammepaji**, filed under Section 482 of the B.N.S.S., 2023 for grant of Anticipatory Bail, apprehending their arrest in connection with Crime No. 586/2025, registered at Police Station – Basantpur, District – Rajnandgaon (C.G.) for alleged commission of offence punishable under Sections 34(2) of the C.G. Excise Act and Section 111 of the BNS, is **dismissed** as not maintainable, in view of Section 59-A of the Chhattisgarh Excise Act.
